## TWELVE FLORIDA COUNTY TAX COLLECTORS SELECT BID4ASSETS TO CONDUCT 2007 TAX LIEN AUCTIONS ONLINE

Number of Florida Tax Collectors to Conduct Tax Sale Online - -*

**SILVER SPRING, MD., May 1, 2007** - Bid4Assets, Inc., the nation's leader in online auction solutions for federal, state and local government, announced today that twelve Florida County Tax Collectors' offices will conduct their 2007 Tax Lien Sale with Bid4Assets. A dedicated, unique website will be available this week for each tax sale and will include information on registration, bidding and deposit procedures and deadlines. The tax sale sites will also provide interested participants with a resource center and a demonstration site to allow participants to familiarize themselves with the auction system.
