Calaveras County Holds Its Annual Tax Sale Online With Bid4Assets.com

April 1, 2010 - Calaveras County – Treasurer-Tax Collector of Calaveras County, Lynette Norfolk, announced today that the county will hold its annual auction event for tax-defaulted properties online with Bid4Assets, a company specializing in online real estate auctions. The online auctions will be open for bidding May 8 and close Tuesday, May 11. The auctions are available for preview online <http://www.bid4assets.com/Calaveras>.

Starting bid prices begin as low as \$1,950 for the 14 properties. There is a \$2,500 deposit requirement to be eligible to bid plus a \$15 processing fee. The deposit is due no later than Tuesday, May 4th. Properties are sold as is; bidders are required to conduct their own due diligence. In online tax sale auctions, the minimum bid price for a property is set at the amount of back taxes owed to the county on that property plus auction expenses. In every one of these auctions, the high bidder on the auction wins. The benefit of tax sale auctions is that properties that are tax-defaulted get put back onto the tax rolls and continue to generate revenue for the county. Calaveras County is one of dozens of counties across the country that uses Bid4Assets for their annual tax sales. Other counties in California have included Napa, San Bernardino, Imperial, Del Norte, Kern, Lassen, Plumas, San Diego, Siskiyou, Fresno, Kings, Merced, Tulare, Santa Cruz and many more.
